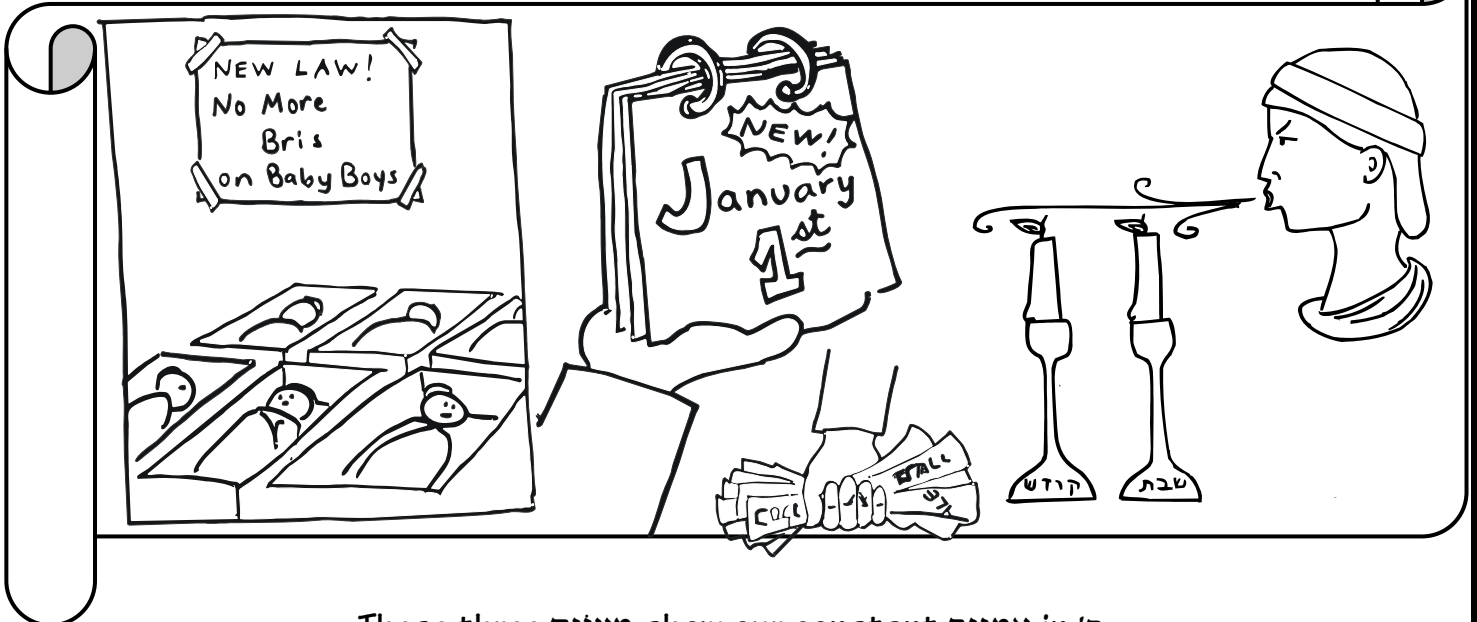




מִצְוֹת made special harsh decrees against three:

These three מִצְוֹת show our constant אֱמוּנָה in ה':

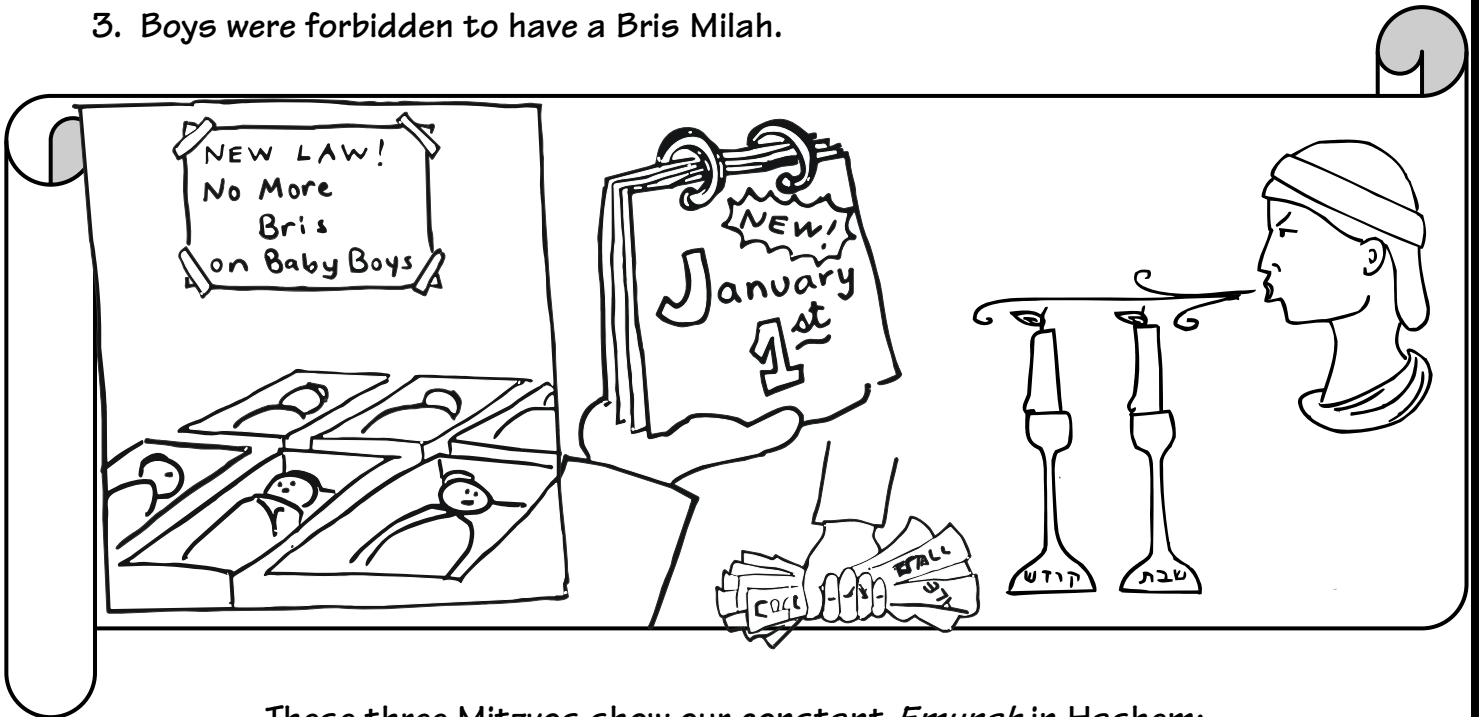
שַׁבָּת	Calendar / ראש חודש	בְּרִית מִילָה
Through resting on שַׁבָּת, we show our אֱמוּנָה that ה' created the world. By keeping שַׁבָּת holy, we demonstrate that ה' still creates and runs the world.	Through ראש חודש we turn ימים טובים, which shows that "time" itself which is a "symbol" of nature can and is - made holy.	Through the בְּרִית מִילָה we show that the physical body is - and needs to be - holy. Holiness is not only in thoughts, ideas, words and discussions, but our bodies are holy, and we must act and be holy.

As time went on, the situation was getting worse. Many סִפְרֵי תוֹרָה were burnt – along with the teachers who taught from them. King אֲנָטִיכּוֹס commanded his generals to have the מְתִיוֹנִים publicly demonstrate that they had left their people and were enjoying it. The מְתִיוֹנִים were increasing and influencing others to join them. The Jewish Nation was in trouble.

These three Mitzvos show our constant *Emunah* in Hashem:

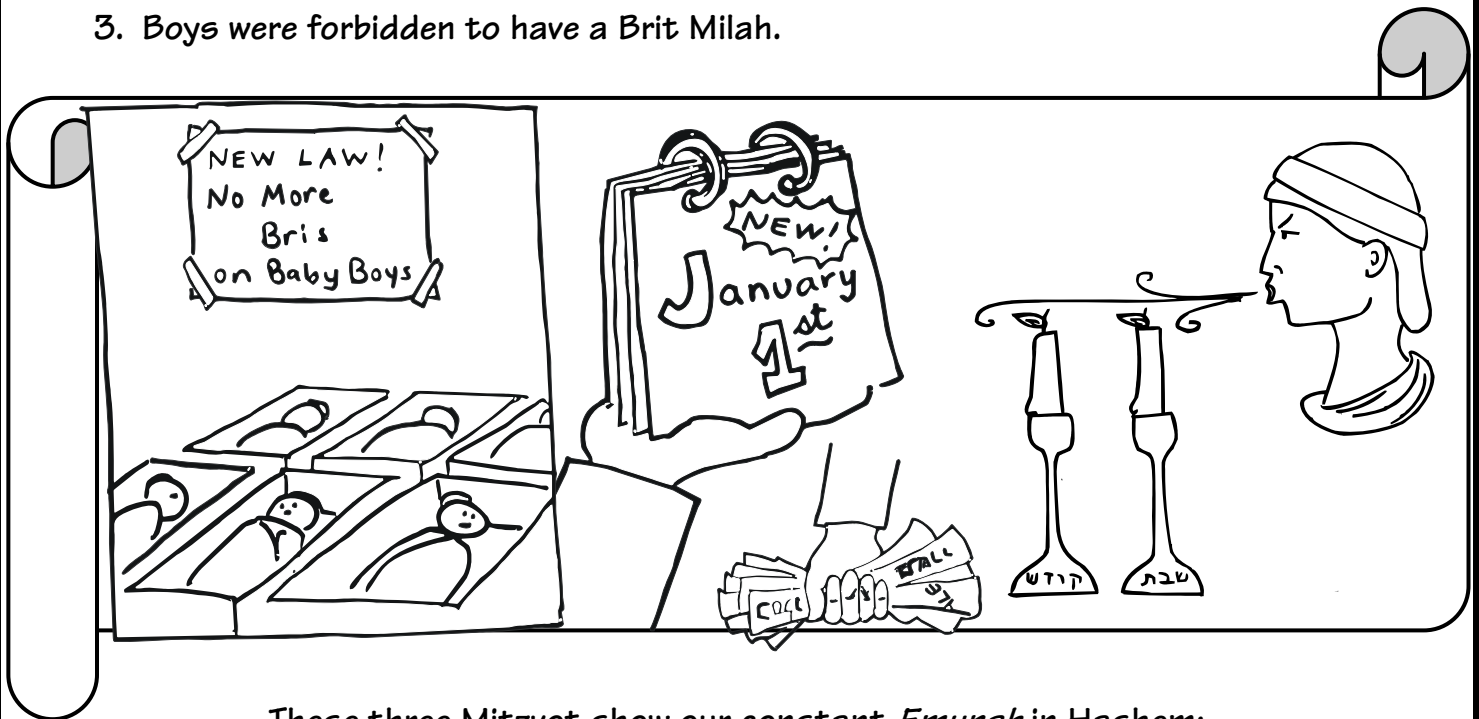
Shabbos	Calendar / Rosh Chodesh	Bris Milah
